



True Cost of Quality Child Care Across Texas Regions

About the Regional True Cost of Care Tables

In November 2022, the Texas Child Care Strategic Plan Workgroup released recommendations to improve the quality of the child care workforce in Texas (hereafter "Workgroup Recommendations").¹ In support of these recommendations, the Prenatal-to-3 Policy Impact Center estimated the true cost of quality child care (TCC) in Texas.² These statewide average figures informed several of the concrete proposals included in the Workgroup Recommendations.

This document updates and expands the cost estimates from the Workgroup Recommendations in two ways. First, we update our estimates of the statewide average TCC to incorporate the latest cost-of-living data (officially "regional price parities") available from the Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA³). Second, we report TCC estimates separately for 26 regions within Texas, including all 25 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) as well as a single estimate for the portion of the state that does not fall within any MSA (i.e., predominately rural areas). Subsidy reimbursement rates are set by Workforce Region, and so localized estimates are vital for understanding disparities between current rates and the true cost of care.

MSAs include cities, their suburbs, and some outlying rural areas. As such, actual TCCs will vary within each region. The TCC within the city limits of Dallas, for example, is likely to be somewhat higher than the average for the larger Dallas-Fort Worth-Arlington MSA.

The tables below report separate sets of TCCs for infants, toddlers, preschool, and schoolage children receiving care in child care centers and one set of TCCs for children receiving home-based child care. Each table includes estimated TCCs for care quality equivalent to Texas Rising Star Two-Star, Three-Star, and Four-Star levels. Consistent with the estimates included in the Workgroup Recommendations, the true cost of home-based care is set to be equivalent the cost of toddler care at the same level of care quality, with more research needed to develop a specifically home-based rate.

All TCCs are estimated in January 2021 dollars and thus do not account for inflation since that time. Additionally, we report all TCCs as monthly costs, consistent with common

practice elsewhere.⁵ To convert monthly costs to daily costs, divide each reported amount by 22 days.

Methodological Notes

The overall methodology for estimating the true cost of quality care is unchanged from the Workgroup Recommendations.⁶ We made the following adjustments to generate regional estimates:

- Expenses subject to a cost-of-living adjustment are now scaled by the appropriate BEA regional price parity (RPP) for the given MSA or for the nonmetropolitan portion of the state, rather than by Texas's statewide RPP. Specifically, we employ the latest 2021 "All-Items" RPPs for each region, as released on December 15, 2022.
- Unlike expenses, the wage scales used to produce statewide TCC estimates are specific to Texas, rather than adjustment from a national baseline. As such, to adjust wages for regions within Texas, we estimate the cost of living in that region relative to the Texas average, not the national average. We accomplish this by dividing the RPP of a given region by the statewide RPP and using this new term as a within-state RPP for wages.⁷

It is worth noting that employing "All Items" RPPs for TCC estimates may wash out some regional variation in commercial real estate prices. As such, actual TCCs for a given MSA may be slightly higher than estimates for regions with more expensive commercial real estate, and vice versa. These estimates could be refined with more information regarding commercial rents and mortgage costs across the state.

⁷ To illustrate, the 2021 RPP for Texas is 98.5 (compared to a national average of 100). The 2021 RPP for the Amarillo MSA is 93.8. Comparing the two terms, we see that the cost of living in Amarillo MSA is 93.8% of the national average, but 95.2% of the Texas average.
